

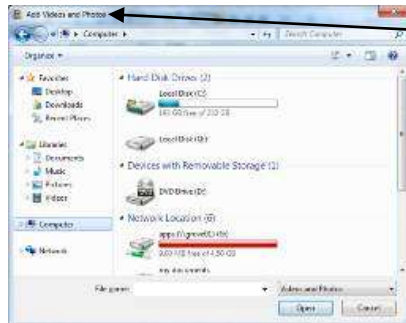
Create a Video in Movie Maker – Using Still Images (photos)

1. Launch Movie Maker

Click → Start → Programs → Windows Live Movie Maker

2. Add Pictures:

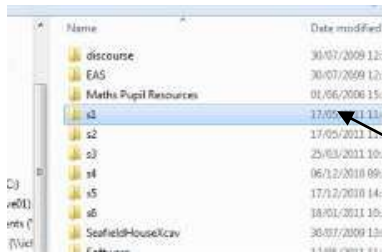
i From the **Home** tab  click **Add videos and photos**



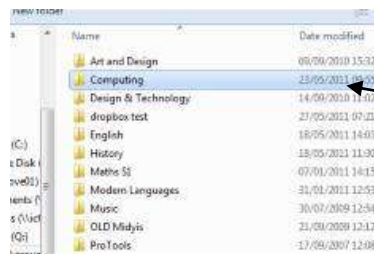
ii The Add videos and photos window opens.
Scroll down until you find **subjects (grove01)(S:)**



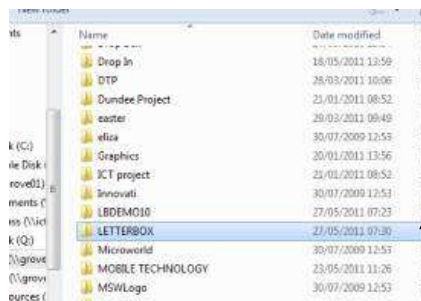
iii Double click **subjects (grove01)(S:)**



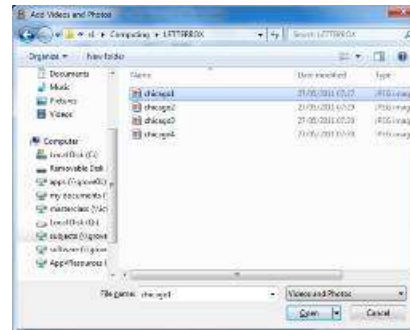
iv Double click **s1**



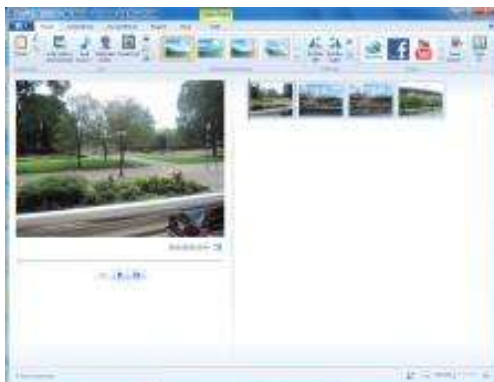
v Double click **Computing**



vi Double click **LETTERBOX**



vii The window will now display 4 files – chicago1 chicago4.
To select the files:
Hold down the Ctrl key and click all the 4 photos and then click Open.

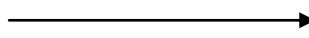



viii The 4 files – chicago1 chicago4 will now appear in the Movie Maker window and are ready for editing.

3. Add Title:

From the **Home** tab  click the **Add Title** button 

Type in your title - Chicago Tour





use the Background colour  button

and Font colour  button (to choose different colours)

4. Set Playing time (Duration) for photo:

Select the **photo** (by clicking on it)

Click on the Video Tools **Edit** tab 

Change the **Duration** value  from 7.00 to 3.00 

The playing time for the **Title** can be set in the same way.

5. Add a Transition / Pan and Zoom

Click on the **Animations** tab 

You can then choose to apply a **Transition** or **Pan and Zoom** effect.

Transitions

Click on the **Transition** you would like to apply. The transition will be previewed on screen.



The full range of transitions can be viewed by clicking on the scroll buttons.

Pan and Zoom

Click on the **Pan and Zoom** you would like to apply. The pan and zoom will be previewed on screen.



The full range of pan and zooms can be viewed by clicking on the scroll buttons.

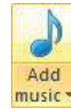
Remove a Transition / Pan and Zoom

Select **photo** or **photos** and click on the left hand option – **No Transition / No Pan and Zoom**



6. Add Music

From the **Home** tab  click the **Add Music** button



Click **Add Music** 

Navigate to **mp3** or **wav** audio/music: 

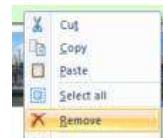
Click **Open** 

Music track will appear above photo clips



Remove Music

Right click on music track and click **Remove**



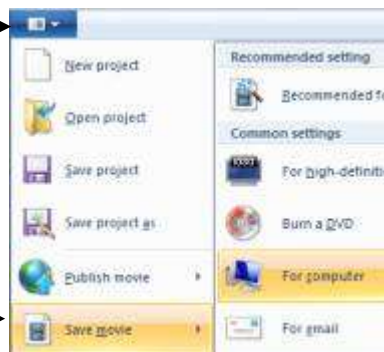
7. Previewing the video

Click on **Play** button which is below the preview window



8. Saving the Video (Movie) – To the Computer (as a wmv file)

i Click **Movie Maker** button →




ii Click on **Save movie** →

iii Click **For computer**

iv **Navigate** to where you want to **Save** your movie file

v Type in a **name** for your file

vi Click **Save** button 

Your movie will be saved and can be played in any media player



Importing Video from a device:

1. **Connect a device** eg. **Flipvideo** to your computer

Connect the device to the USB socket on the computer and turn on the device.

2. **Browse** for videos and photos on device

Click the link →  Click here to browse for videos and photos

3. **Choose the device**

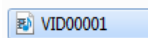
Click the device eg. **Flipvideo** you want to import videos and photos from.



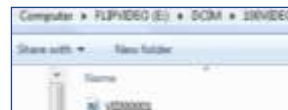
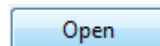
4. **Choose the videos and photos**


Navigate to where your **video** is stored

Click on the **video file**



Click **Open**



The video file →  will now appear in the Movie Maker window, ready for editing.

Editing a video or video clip:

There are 3 types of editing available – **Trimming**, **Splitting** and **Setting play speed**

To Trim a video

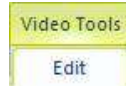
Trim means to remove part of the video. You can trim (remove) the beginning and end of a video so that you only show the part you want. You do this by setting a new **start point** and a new **end point**.

To set a new start point

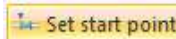
1. Drag the **slider** to the point where you want the video to **start**



2. Click on the Video Tools **Edit** tab



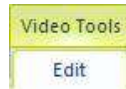
3. Click on the **Set start point** button



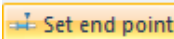
4. Drag the **slider** to the point where you want the video to **end**



5. Click on the Video Tools **Edit** tab



6. Click on the **Set end point** button



7. Click on the **Trim tool** button

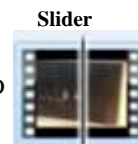


If you only want to **trim** the **start** of a video, carry out **steps 1, 2, 3 & 7**

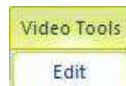
If you only want to **trim** the **end** of a video, carry out **steps 4, 5, 6 & 7**

To split a video

1. Drag the **slider** to the point where you want to **split** the video



2. Click on the Video Tools **Edit** tab



3. Click on the **Split** button



The video will now be **split** into 2 video clips

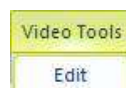


To change the speed of a video

Select the **video clip** (by clicking on it)



Click on the Video Tools **Edit** tab



Click the **Speed** button



Change the **Speed** by clicking a new value
